APPLICATION:

Italian citizens: written and oral test. The candidate should also prove the knowledge of a foreign language (to be choosed among English, French, Spanish, Portuguese, German).

Citizens from foreign countries: oral test, attended in presence or via Skype. The candidate is supposed to submit to the commission the PhD Project.

The PhD program promotes an interdisciplinary methodology, taking into account History of law, Comparative law, Civil law (substantive and procedural).

THE PHD PROGRAM HAS TWO SPECIFIC PATHS:

1) JUDICIAL REMEDIES, MANAGEMENT AND COMPANY LAW

The path aims at educating the student in managing complex legal issues with an interdisciplinary approach, from both a substantive and a procedural legal perspective, taking into account legal comparison and issues of internationalization. Attending students will be guided and directed, integrating theoretical knowledge with practical training in judicial institutions, professional organizations, business management and administration.

2) ROMAN LAW, CIVIL LAW AND COMPARATIVE LAW

The path aims at providing a deep knowledge and understanding of Roman Law and its fundamental role in the formation of the private law in the contemporary legal systems. The program is focused in particular in the study of Europe, Latin America, Islamic Countries and China's legal system. The students will compare the civil law institutes of the various Countries also with historical legal method (diachronic and synchronic analysis of specific legal issues).
